RSL workshop targets membership

A full-day strategic workshop has identified membership as a major target for the future growth of the Returned & Services League in Western Australia.

The workshop, facilitated by Peter Fitzpatrick, a veteran who is also managing director of Crusader Management Group, comprised the State Executive of the RSL and staff. It was held on 24 March.

State RSL President Graham Edwards said the workshop was invigorating and would help set a new course for the League.

"The workshop set an ambitious goal of doubling our membership by 2020 – with an immediate target of increasing it by 10 per cent by the end of this year," Mr Edwards said.

"Such a goal requires immediate action such as reviewing Constitutional hurdles and reviewing membership categories. We will need a much better-resourced recruitment team as well as clear and attractive benefits for members."

The workshop also set important internal and external goals for the RSL as part of its 2020 strategy.

This included improving the level of internal communications and governance between the RSL Board, sub-branches and staff; improving the image and perception of the RSL within the broad community including government and ex-service organisations; identifying and securing a diverse and sustainable fundraising base; and ensuring the delivery and continuation of a quality assistance and advisory service.

ANZAC Day

The RSL is well advanced in planning ANZAC Day 2014. With public interest continuing to grow we expect strong turn outs at services throughout the State. Channel 9 will broadcast live the Dawn Service at the State War Memorial.

Women We Need You

The program for our Women's Forum being held at ANZAC House on Saturday 23 August 2014 is coming together nicely.

The main focus of the forum will be a workshop where you will get to tell us what you think we can do to increase the membership of women in the RSL and what sorts of activities and programs will appeal to you going forward. After the forum we will be working on a long term plan to grow our services for women.

We plan on having speakers from the Australian Defence Force, including Brigadier Steve Coggan talk to us on the day about their experiences of the roles of women in the ADF and we have Associate Professor Linley Lord from Curtin University facilitating our workshop. We are also in the process of inviting some other speakers that will be of great interest to everyone.

We are appealing to all sub-branches to nominate a woman who can write a story about what military unit they served in and about their time with the RSL. We want to find out what the RSL means to them and what it has done for them so that we can publish their stories in a special booklet for the forum.

There are many outstanding women in our sub-branches and we want them to inspire others.

Donna Prytulak chairs the RSL's Working Party for a special State Women's Forum to be held on Saturday, 23 August. The forum is being held at ANZAC House and all female members are invited. Donna is a member of the State Executive, President of Northam Sub-Branch and Secretary of the Northam Sub-Branch Women's Aux.

Insurance Reminder



You may be eligible for concession stamps

Do you have a Federal Government concession card? You may be eligible for a reduced rate on domestic stamps, and other offers. Apply for a free MyPost Concession Account today!

- Ability to purchase up to 50 concession stamps per year
- Discount on Mail Hold and Mail Redirection
- A free MyPost Concession Card and digital mailbox

How to apply

- 1. Check if you're eligible using the list below
- 2. Complete and print out the application form from the Australia Post Website.
- 3. Take the form to your closest post office, along with your valid Federal Government concession card
- 4. Receive your free booklet of 5 stamps and your MyPost card in the mail within 14 days

Am I eligible for a MyPost Concession Account?

The following Australian Federal Government concession cards are accepted as proof of eligibility for a MyPost Concession Account:

- Pensioner Concession Card
- Health Care Card
- Commonwealth Seniors Health Card
- Department of Veterans' Affairs Card
- Veterans' Repatriation Health Card

An Afghan War Day

Australia is going to have an ANZAC Day style national commemoration for the war in Afghanistan, to ensure the bitter experience of returning Vietnam Veterans is not repeated for those who have served in Australia's longest war.

21 March next year will be the first national day of commemoration for the war in Afghanistan.

The Government intends to stage the commemoration once, leaving open the possibility that it could become an annual event. State governments have agreed on a national day of commemoration but it will not be a public holiday like ANZAC Day.
