Governor congratulates RSLWA for ANZAC Day

The Honourable Kim Beazley AC, Governor of Western Australia, has formally congratulated RSLWA on its delivery of ANZAC Day 2020 commemorations.

In a letter to the State President Peter Aspinall from Government House, received by State Branch on Tuesday, 26 May, 2020, the Governor recognised the efforts of RSLWA for what was a very unusual, yet highly successful, ANZAC Day.

"I think the Board and yourself can be enormously proud of the honour you did our current and past serving personnel and particularly those who paid the supreme sacrifice." Governor Beazley wrote.

The State President has thanked all those Sub-Branches who, in their own way, contributed to the way ANZAC Day was conducted under difficult and unprecedented circumstances.

Congress @ ANZAC House

Great news for us all as we start emerging from the COVID-19 pandemic. It is now confirmed that RSLWA's 104th State Congress will be held in the new ANZAC House.

As advised earlier this month, formal approval has been provided to RSLWA to conduct the State Congress on Saturday, 26 September, 2020. Congress will take place on Level 5 of ANZAC House Veteran Central, with similar timings to the previous Congresses.

The actual number of members and guests able to attend this year's Congress will, of course, depend on advice from the State Government as to allowable numbers, given any remaining limitations on social distancing and public gatherings come September.

This week, all Sub-Branches will receive notice of submission of Motions to be considered for presentation and debate at Congress.

Congress motions need to be received by State Branch by **4pm on Friday, 7 August, 2020**.

Motions need to be State or National in character, of an affirmative nature, and accompanied by adequate preamble and support material.

Sub-Branch motions must be approved by a majority vote of those present at a properly constituted meeting of that Sub-Branch and signed by no less than five (5) financial members of the Sub-Branch present at that meeting.

As per the RSLWA Constitution, please be advised of the following dates and details:

Date	By-Law	Action
7 August	9.39	All resolutions for State Congress are to be in the hands of the CEO at least six weeks before the date of the commencement of Congress. *
21 August		A copy of the complete agenda shall be forwarded to reach Sub-Branch Secretaries four weeks' prior to the opening of Congress. *
4 September	9.3a	The nomination of Congress delegates for a Sub-Branch shall be in writing from the Sub-Branch and received at RSLWA not later than 14 days prior to the opening of State Congress. *
